Scott broke the England-Australia solo flight record in 1931, flying a de Havilland DH.60 Moth.[citation needed] For this achievement, the King awarded him the Air Force Cross in 1931. Competing against fellow pilots such as Bert Hinkler, Charles Kingsford Smith and Jim Mollison, Scott went on to beat the Australia-England solo flight record in 1932 and then re-took the England-Australia the same year. In 1934, he was picked, along with Tom Campbell Black, to fly one of three purpose-built de Havilland DH.88 Comet Racers to compete in the MacRobertson Air Race, which is still considered the world's greatest air race. Scott and Black won the race, breaking the England-Australia flight record of 162 hours down to 52 hours and 33 minutes. They reached the finish line in Melbourne in 71 hours, winning the £10,000 prize money and becoming world-famous overnight. Following the race, Scott received several medals and awards, including the Gold Medal of the Royal Aero Club and was celebrated wherever he went, including invitations from King Edward VIII. Served with the Luftwaffe in WWII with JG 51 and has 50 recorded victories against enemy aircraft, flying mainly the ME 109. Gaining his RK on 8th April 1944. Major Kurt Huhn Knights Cross of the Iron Cross Born on August 1st, 1912, in Paaren (Osthavelland), Germany, he began his military career on 1st March 1933 as a cadet of the German police force. Transferred to Luftwaffe on 1st October 1935, he was trained as a dive bomber pilot and, upon completion of his course, was assigned to serve, as Leutnant, in 4./St.G 165 (4th Staffel of Stukageschwader 165), then headquartered in Schweinfurt. After participating in the invasion of Yugoslavia (April 1941), Huhn and his unit would be moved to the east in order to take part in the invasion of the USSR (Operation Barbarossa). In the early months of the advance on the Russian steppes, the Stukas led by Huhn would play a decisive role in the siege and destruction of large Soviet forces (the battles of the pockets - Kesselschachten). At the same time, the Hauptmann Huhn also began to accumulate the function of Operations Officer of the St.G 77. Named on 01.07.1942 Kommandeur of II./St.G 77, Huhn led this unit during the Battle of Stalingrad, when his Stukas were the main air support force available to the German 6th Army trapped in the besieged city. Despite the tragic outcome of the battle, Huhn's leadership was recognized, and on March 17th, 1943, he was awarded the Iron Cross Knight Cross, after more than 400 combat missions. Huhn remained in the front of combat until August of 1943, when it was transferred to the 9th School of Flight of War (Luftkriegsschule 9 - LKS 9), to act like instructor of flight and tactics of combat. From December 1943, Huhn assumed the position of Chief Inspector of the LKS 1 and LKS 2 schools, where he would remain until the end of the war in May 1945. Of note is that, as the battle became more violent and desperate, the planes began to operate closer to the front of the battle, in order to allow more missions to be performed daily. Having executed a total of 550 combat missions (of which at least 400 in Russia), always aboard the Junkers Ju 87 Stuka, Major Kurt Huhn passed away on September 3rd, 1997, at the age of 85 in Germany. Major Hans Ekkehard Bob Knights Cross of the Iron Cross, He was a German Fighter pilot, serving with the Luftwaffe. During World War II, Bob flew approximately seven hundred combat Missions, and claimed sixty victories; thirty-seven of which were on the eastern front. In 1939, shortly before the Invasion of Poland, Bob was transferred to the newly formed 3./JG 21 (later known as the Devils Squadron) which was redesignated at June 6, 1940, into 9./JG 54. It was equipped with the Bf 109 fighter, an aircraft Bob would become very familiar with over the years, flying every model except the Kurfurst. During the Battle of Britain 9./JG 54 was activated as a Jabo (fighter-bomber) unit, targeting shipping vessels. By Nov 1940, Bob had recorded 19 kills, and was awarded the Ritterkreuz des Eisernen Kreuzes by Reichsmarschall Hermann Goring on March 7, 1941. On September 29, 1942, Bob had his 50th victory, and was promoted to Hauptmann. On April 17, 1943, Bob recorded his 57th Victory; the ramming of a USAAF Boeing B-17 Bomber near Bremen with his Bf 109 G-6. He bailed out and survived the crash without injury. On August 1, Bob was promoted to the rank of Major and was appointed Gruppenkommandeur of IV./JG 54. By May 1944, Bob was back at the Western front as Gruppenkommandeur of II./JG 3; based in the Normandy invasion front corridor, flying Reichsverteidigung (Defense of the Reich) duties. In August he was transferred to Erprobungskommando 262 where he learned to fly the Me 262. In early 1945 his experience led to his becoming a member of Generalmajor Josef Kammhuber's staff. Bob was responsible for allocating newly built Me-262's to operational units Bob was one of the aces chosen to fly as a member of the jet fighter unit JV 44, led by Adolf Galland. The cover carries a more detailed description of his career inside Hauptmann Josef Haibock Knights Cross of the Iron Cross The Knight's Cross of the Iron Cross was awarded to recognise extreme battlefield bravery or successful military leadership. Josef Haibock joined the Austrian Bundesheer in 1956 and retired in 1977 as a General Major. During his career he was credited with 77 aerial victories in 600+ missions. Aviator badge Front Flying Clasp of the Luftwaffe Iron Cross (1939) 2nd Class 1st Class Wound Badge (1939) in Black or Silver German Cross in Gold on 17th October 1943 as Hauptmann in the 1./Jagdgeschwader 52 Knight's Cross of the Iron Cross on 9th June 1944 as Hauptmann and Gruppenkommandeur of the I./Jagdgeschwader 3 Udet. Potter began a brilliant career in the Luftwaffe. After various assignments in France and on the Eastern front, Potter became an ace. Joachim Potter was appointed Gruppenkommandeur of I./KG 77 commanded the first Group of the 77th Kampfgeschwader on 25 October 1941. He was eventually awarded the Knight's Cross of the Iron Cross on April 16, 1942. The Knight's Cross of the Iron Cross principally was the highest award of Germany to recognize extreme battlefield bravery or successful military leadership during World War II. Poetter participated on all of the major fronts in the European Theatre, until the dissolution of his unit in 1944. When he returned to West Germany after war, Poetter enlisted again in the new German Army, the Bundeswehr, in 1955. He became colonel (Oberst) in the West German Air Force (Bundesluftwaffe). After his military retirement, on March 1971, Joachim Poetter died on 17 November 1992. Leutnant Johann Pichler Knights Cross of the Iron Cross. He was one of the stalwarts of JG77, serving with that Unit throughout the war. He served in the Mediterranean theatre, scoring his first victory on 16.05.1941 - a Hurricane. He continued his success when JG77 moved to Russia before returning to the Med again in 1943. JG77 in 1944 began to encounter US heavy bombers on a regular basis and Pichler scored well against these formidable adversaries. He scored 75 Victories, which included 16 four engine bombers. 145 - WW2 Luftwaffe aces signed Adler Tag Cover Major Elmar Schaefer KC, Hauptmann Diether Lukesch KC. Major Elmar Schaefer Knights Cross of the Iron Cross, As Oberleutnant Elmar Schaefer and Lt. Martin Mobus and veteran observer Unteroffizier Gerhard Grenzel, became the first Stuka crews to receive the Knight's Cross of the Iron Cross. Receiving it on the 8th May 1940 Hauptmann Diether Lukesch Knights Cross of the Iron Cross with Oak Leaves (born July 15, 1918, in Hadersdorf-Weidlingau, Penzing, Wien - died February 28, 2004) was German World War II Luftwaffe bomber pilot. During the course of the war he was decorated with Knight's Cross of the Iron Cross and Oak Leaves. He was one of the first pilots to carry out jet bombing missions flying the Arado Ar 234. In October 1944, as his Arado training proceeded, Lukesch was awarded Oak Leaves to his Knight's Cross of the Iron Cross. On the day before Christmas 1944, Lukesch led nine Ar 234B-2s in the first jet bombing missions ever, supporting the German counterattack out of the Ardennes. The target was a factory complex at Liège, Belgium. In the days that followed, Lukesch and the Arado pilots attacked Allied troops, rail yards, and other positions. On New Year's Day 1945, Lukesch led history's first jet, night-bombing sortie, attacking targets at Brussels and Liège. He concluded the war with a total of 436 bombing and long-range reconnaissance missions. He was taken prisoner of war by the American forces and released on 27 July 1945. After WWII Lukesch at first worked for US Armed Forces in Austria. He then became a commercial airline pilot, flying for 18 years first with KLM, and later Lufthansa. Good condition Est. £36 - 40

Oberst Johannes Schalk Knights Cross of the Iron Cross (19 September 1903 - 9 November 1987) was a flying ace and high ranking officer in the German Luftwaffe during World War II. He is credited with 15 aerial victories, 4 of which on the Eastern front, claimed in 163 combat missions. He joined the Austrian Bundesheer in 1922 and as a Leutnant was trained to fly in 1928. He became a leader of a fighter squadron in August 1933 and was appointed commander of the Austrian Jagdgruppe 1 (1st fighter group) He was one of the best Austrian aerobatic pilots and gained experience at various delegations to Germany and Italy. After the Anschluss, the annexation of Austria and the integration of the Bundesheer into the German Wehrmacht, Schalk became Gruppenkommandeur (group commander) of the IV./Jagdgeschwader 134 (4th group of fighter wing 134) on 1 August 1938. This unit was later renamed and became the nucleus of III./Zerstörergeschwader 26 (ZG 26-destroyer wing 26) on 1 May 1939. Schalk claimed five aerial victories during the Battle of France and six during the Battle of Britain, three of which were shot down by his wireless radio operator Unteroffizier Scheuplein. He was one of the first members of the Luftwaffe to receive the Ehrenpokal der Luftwaffe and the first Zerstörer (destroyer) pilot to receive the Knight's Cross of the Iron Cross (Ritterkreuz des Eisernen Kreuzes) on 11 September 1940 after nine aerial victories. Oberstleutnant Georg Christl Knights Cross of the Iron Cross. Born on 3 October 1913 at Pfaffenberg in Niederbayern. Christl participated in the Battle of Britain with III./ZG 26. On 31 August 1940 he escorted Do 17 bombers to raid Duxford and was intercepted by RAF fighters. His aircraft was hit and Oberleutnant Christl was obliged to crash-land back at his base Arques in France. Christl was Staffelführer of 7./ZG 26 based on Sicily flying Bf 110s in December 1940. His role was to protect the supply routes from Italy to North Africa. He would also be called upon to attack enemy shipping, perform reconnaissance missions and freie Jagd patrols and support the ground forces during the campaign in North Africa. He also participated in the invasion of Yugoslavia and flew missions over Malta. On 9 April 1941, Hauptmann Christl was leading 7./ZG 76, escorting He 111 bombers raiding Tobruk harbour. The formation was intercepted by RAF Hurricanes and during the ensuing combat Christl claimed one shot down. His victim was the RAF ace Flying Officer. George Goodman (12.666 destroyed and 2.333 damaged victories) of 73 Sqn, who force-landed within the outer defences of Tobruk unhurt. In December 1941, 7./ZG 26 was transferred to Derna in North Africa to counter the Allied counter-attack, Operation Crusader. Hauptmann Christl assumed command of III./ZG 76 on 25 December 1941. He was to lead the Gruppe until its withdrawal from the Mediterranean theatre, being awarded the Ritterkreuz for his leadership in the desert on 18 March 1942. He finally relinquished command on 12 July 1943 when the Gruppe was withdrawn from Italy back to Germany. Christl was transferred to a staff role with the General der Jagdflieger. Major Christl was posted to Parchim in July 1944 to command Jagdgruppe 10, an experimental testing unit of specialised anti-Bomber weapons, until the end of war. Georg Christl was credited with seven victories, although one source has credited him a victory total of 19. Good condition Est. £36 - 40

Hauptmann Alois Magg Knights Cross of the Iron Cross Flew with the Luftwaffe with KG2 Holzhammer, and flew Do17s, Do217s, Ju188s & Me410s Awarded his Iron Cross on the 5th of September 1944. Commanded Stuka 15./NJG 2 from 01.12.44 to 29.04.45 Hauptmann Heinrich Schmetz Knights Cross of the Iron Cross After beginning his lifetime in aviation piloting gliders at age 14, Schmetz entered the Luftwaffe in 1935 and after navigator training was sent to Kampfgeschwader (KG) 253, the General Wever bomber wing, where he flew the Junkers 52, Dornier 23 and Junkers 86. In late 1937, he entered the reserves and resumed studies for a degree in aeronautical engineering. A few days before the blitzkrieg into Poland, he was recalled to active service in his old wing, now re-designed KG 4. In the spring of 1940, Schmetz was assigned to 7./KG 4 and often flew missions with the Staffelführer, Hajo Herrmann, first in the Heinkel 111 and later in the Junkers 88. He participated in the attack on France and the Low Countries and then in Operation Weserübung, the campaign into Denmark and Norway. During the Battle of Britain, Schmetz flew night missions against British industrial complexes and coastal shipping. When his bomber unit moved to Sicily, he saw action from Gibraltar to Greece. On a spectacular night attack on Piraeus harbour, Schmetz scored a direct hit on the British ammunition ship Clan Frazier. The explosion sank eleven ships and devastated the port. In late 1941, he returned to the Western Front to fly reconnaissance over the North Sea and English Channel. In 1942, this skilled navigator went to pilot training. After earning his pilot's badge, he was moved to a unit testing radio-controlled bombs, the first effective guided munitions. In 1943, Schmetz was assigned to KG 100 in Dornier 217's. When the allies made amphibious landings at Salerno, KG 100 mounted an attack. Schmetz scored his first victories in September, hitting the British battleship Warspite and sinking the Italian battleship Roma. He was chosen to command III/KG 100, a bomber group, just in time to defend against the Normandy invasion. As the allied beachhead expanded, Schmetz led a composite unit of German airmen, soldiers, and sailors in an epic retreat from southern France. As the allied armies closed in on his homeland, Schmetz became manager for unguided rockets, working with Wernher von Braun. After the war, he worked for the French navy, ironically using Junkers 188s, testing captured German guided bombs. In 1956, he joined the newly created Bundeswehr, serving on weapons evaluation teams. In 1965 in Dayton, Ohio, he worked on joint German-American projects to develop a vertical/short take-off and landing fighter. Returning to Europe, he worked on NATO's Panavia fighter program, and the MILAN anti-tank and the ROLAND anti-aircraft missiles. He ended his active duty service as liaison to the US Army, Redstone Arsenal. Good condition Est. £36 - 40

148 - WW2 Luftwaffe aces signed Adler Tag Cover Oberstleutnant Helmut Bennemann KC, Oberstleutnant Bernard Woldenga KC. Oberstleutnant Bernard Woldenga Knights Cross of the Iron Cross Born 4 December 1901 in Hamburg and died 19 January 1999. During World War II Woldenga served in the German Luftwaffe commanded the JG 27 and JG 77 fighter wings. Woldenga's career started as a captain in the merchant marine. He started his flight training in 1928 and worked as chief pilot for the FVK Warnemünde. He transferred to the newly emerging Luftwaffe, taking command as Gruppenkommandeur of the I./Jagdgeschwader 131 (JG 131) - later renamed to I./Jagdgeschwader 1 (JG 1) - on 1 April 1937. With this unit he participated in the invasion of Poland in 1939. He surrendered command of the Gruppe on 1 February 1940 and was transferred to the

Reichsluftfahrtministerium. He briefly led Jagdgeschwader 27 (JG 27) on the Channel Front from 11 October to 22 October 1940 before he was made Geschwaderkommodore of Jagdgeschwader 77 (JG 77). JG 77 distinguished itself under his leadership in the Balkans Campaign and invasion of Crete. JG 77 claimed 50 aerial victories, 114 ground victories, sank 5 fast attack crafts and 81,000 gross register tons (GRT) of merchant shipping. Woldenga himself flew numerous ground support missions. He received the Knight's Cross of the Iron Cross (Ritterkreuz des Eisernen Kreuzes) for these accomplishments. He again took command of JG 27 on 21 June 1941 on the Russian front during Operation Barbarossa and claimed 4 aerial victories. He relocated the Geschwaderstab to North Africa in December 1941. He was appointed Flieger Führer Balkan on 10 June 1942. His last service position of the war was commander of the Luftkriegsschule 10 in Fürstenwalde near Berlin He is credited with three aerial victories of which 2 were claimed on the Eastern front. Oberstleutnant Helmut Bennemann Knights Cross of the Iron Cross. Born 16th March 1915 and died 17th November 2007. During World War II Bennemann served in the German Luftwaffe claiming 93 aerial victories in over 400 combat missions. The majority of his victories were claimed over the Eastern front. His commands included Geschwaderkommodore of the JG 53 fighter wing. He held the position of Adjutant of I./JG 52 in June 1940. He claimed his first aerial victory on 26 August, when he shot down a RAF Spitfire near Dover. On 15 September, Bennemann claimed three RAF Hurricane shot down to record his sixth through eighth victories. On 27 April 1941, he was appointed Staffelkapitän of 3./JG 52. By the time I./JG 52 was transferred to the Eastern front in September 1941, Bennemann had claimed 12 victories. On 14 June 1942, Bennemann was promoted to Gruppenkommandeur of I./JG 52. By the End of 1942 his score stood at 72 victories. With his score at 88 victories, Bennemann was severely wounded by the explosion of an incendiary bomb on 10 May 1943. Convalescence kept him from combat duty for some months. Bennemann was appointed Geschwaderkommodore of JG 53 on 9 November 1943, taking over command from Oberst Günther Freiherr von Maltzahn. On 25 April 1944, he shot down a USAAF B-24 over Bologna to claim his 90th victory. However, his Bf 109G-6 (W.Nr. 163 314) Black 3 was hit by defensive fire and Bennemann was again wounded, baling out successfully. In June 1944, Bennemann led the Geschwaderstab of JG 53 on a short return to the Eastern front, to direct the supply missions for the relief of the city of Vilna. The unit departed Russia for Wunstorf near Hannover in Germany on 22 July. From August 1944, Bennemann led JG 53 on Reichsverteidigung missions, initially from bases in France, then from bases in Germany. He claimed his last three victories in October 1944 to bring his final score to 93. Among his 93 victories are at least 10 Il-2 Sturmoviks claimed over the Eastern front. In early 1945 he participated in the conspiracy against the Reichsmarschall and chief of the Luftwaffe Hermann Goering in what is referred to as the Fighter Pilots Revolt. 149 - WW2 Luftwaffe ace signed Adler Tag Cover Oberleutnant Gerhard Krems KC, Major Erich Rudorffer KC. Major Erich Rudorffer Knights Cross with Oak Leaves and Swords (born 1 November 1917) is a German former Luftwaffe fighter ace, one of a handful who served with the Luftwaffe through the whole of World War II. He is 7th most successful fighter pilot in the history of air warfare, and currently both the oldest jet fighter ace, and the most successful ace still living. Rudorffer claimed a total of 222 victories, fighting in all the major German theatres of war, including the European and Mediterranean Theatre of Operations During the war he flew more than 1000 combat missions, was engaged in aerial combat over 300 times, was shot down by flak and enemy fighters 16 times and had to take to his parachute 9 times. His 222 aerial victories include 58 heavily armoured Il-2 Sturmovik ground attack aircraft. He was also responsible for sinking a British submarine. Rudorffer got his first victory over a Curtiss Hawk 75, on 14 May 1940. He scored eight more times before the capitulation of France. He flew throughout the Battle of Britain, and legend has him being pursued down Croydon High Street below rooftop level by a Hurricane. He achieved his nineteenth victory on 1 May 1941; he was then awarded the Ritterkreuz and appointed Staffelkapitän of 6./JG 2 the following month. By the end of December 1941 he had claimed 40 kills. In July 1943 Hauptmann Rudorffer was appointed to command II./JG 54 on the Eastern Front. He claimed his first victory here on 7 August. Due to the experience gained by fighting the RAF he achieved incredible success. During his first sortie on 24 August 1943, 5 Soviet aircraft were downed in 4 minutes. On 11th October 1943 Erich Rudorffer wrote history when during 17 minutes he claimed 13 kills. He earned his nickname Fighter of Libau on 28 October 1944 near the Latvian city of Libau. While preparing to land he spotted a Soviet task force of about 60 close air support aircraft on its way to attack Libau airfields. He broke off the landing and engaged the enemy without any backup. He drove off the attackers, shooting down nine enemy aircraft within 10 minutes. in the winter of 1944, Major Rudorffer was trained on the Messerschmitt Me 262 Jet fighter. In February 1945 he was recalled to command I./JG 7. Between December 1944 and beginning of April 1945 the I./JG 7 operated from the then newly-built Luftwaffe Airbase in Kaltenkirchen north of Hamburg. So he seems to have been Group Commander more or less for the one month of March 1945. Rudorffer claimed 12 victories with the Me 262, to bring his total to 222. His tally included 136 on the Eastern Front, 26 in North Africa and 60 on the Western Front including 10 heavy bombers. Oberleutnant Gerhard Krems Knights Cross of the Iron Cross Born 4th May 1920, Gerhard Krems joined the Luftwaffe on 9th November 1938 commencing pilot training on 15th March 1939 at LKS (2) Flight Training School, Gatow, Berlin. He graduated to multi-engine training at FFS (C) 3 School at Lönnewitz, 1st November 1939 followed by night and instrument flight training at Stargard, which he completed 15th April 1940. The next day he started operational training on the Do17 at the Reconnaissance Flying School, Grossenhain. Promoted to Leutnant 1st June 1940, Gerhard was sent to a holding unit at Weimer-Hohra to await a posting to operational Staffel. On 15th August 1940 he joined Stabsstaffel/KG 27 in France. During the Battle of Britain, Gerhard completed 39 operational sorties (most of these being in the Heinkel III IG+BA, the subject of this aerofile) and was awarded the Iron Cross Second Class (EK II) 21st October 1940, First Class (EK I) on 18th November 1940. On 22nd April 1941 he was awarded the Bomber Aircrew Qualification Clasp in Bronze for completing 20 operations. The following day Gerhard completed his 39th and final operation over England, after which he along with KG27 was sent east to take part in the invasion of Russia. On 30th June 1941, Gerhard was awarded the Wound Badge, followed by the award of the Silver Aircrew Clasp on 25th July, for completing 60 operations. He was then awarded the Gold Clasp, 10th October 1941, for completing 110 operations, followed by the Honour Goblet on 26th October 1941. Transferring to 2 Staffel KG27 on 27th January 1942, Gerhard became the first in his unit to be awarded the Knights Cross (RK) 25th May 1942. This was followed by the Russian Front Medal on 25th November 1942, and on 20th December 1942 by the Gold Clasp with Pendant for completing 200+ operations. On 15th March 1943, Gerhard gained the Krimschild for the Crimean Campaign. Transferred to Ia/Stab Gen. Kdo. I Fliegerkorps on 21st May 1944 which he served with until the War in Europe ended on 8th May 1945 - 4 days after his 25th birthday - when he was interned by Russian forces. During his wartime service, Gerhard completed 250 operations, and was held in captivity until release on 20th October 1945. From 1946-1950 he studied at Berlin University and graduated as an engineer. During a long career in the water industry, he became internationally well known, especially for his scientific research work for well constructions. He finally retired in 1980. All the above eight covers have a distinctive red map of England and each cover is accompanied with an information guide and photographs of the pilots involved, the mine series of just eight covers was generated by the Aero Philatelic Historian Hans Rossbach.
